## Federal Process

Apply to EI online from home or at a Service Canada Centre on or immediately after your last day worked.

Start biweekly reporting to EI online or by phone.

Once eligible for benefits and the claim is finalized, EI payments are issued through direct deposit or by cheque.

## Provincial Process

After applying for EI, attend a mandatory appointment with Alberta Supports to apply for GoA Bridge to Re-Employment Relief Grant
